Contest is open to any student in the Chapel Hill-Carrboro School system. Judging will be done by the public and by members of the Carrboro Bicycle Coalition and the Carrboro Branch Library Art Committee and will be based on originality and best illustration of happiness and joy with bikes.



CONTEST RULES:

- 1. 1 entry per student
- 2. Poster size must be either $8 \frac{1}{2} \times 11$ or 11×17 , on paper no thicker than posterboard.
- 3. Artwork may be done in marker, crayon, paint, pen and ink, colored pencils, or collage. **No computer stock art or computer-generated art allowed.**
- 4. Must be the student's original work
- 5. No collaborative entries (including assistance by adults)
- 6. Fill out the form on p. 2 and tape the form to the back of your artwork.

EVERY ENTRY WILL BE ENTERED FOR ONE OF THE RAFFLE PRIZES

*All art will be displayed at the Town of Carrboro's Fourth of July celebration at the Carrboro Bicycle Coalition booth. The top 3 winning entries will be mounted and displayed at the Art of the Bike Art Exhibit, which will be on display at the Carrboro Branch Library, June 19–October 7, 2016. Winning entries will also be posted at www.bikecarrboro.com. By submitting artwork, the student gives the Carrboro Bicycle Coalition a non-exclusive right to reproduce and publish the artwork online or in print form. Our thanks to the Carrboro Arts Committee for their generous support of this project.

Completed entries should be dropped off at the Clean Machine Bike Shop 104 W. Main St, Carrboro no later than July 2 (Hours are Mon.–Sat., 10 a.m. to 7 p.m., Sun., 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.)
